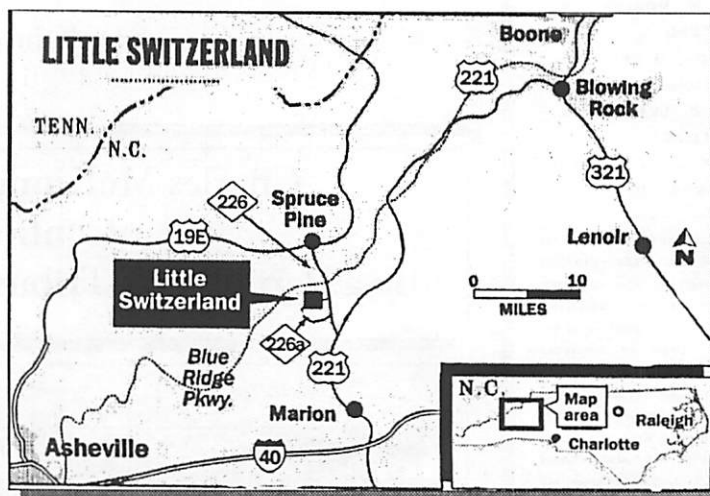
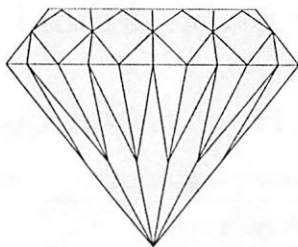
Pertinent Information and Lodging Notes

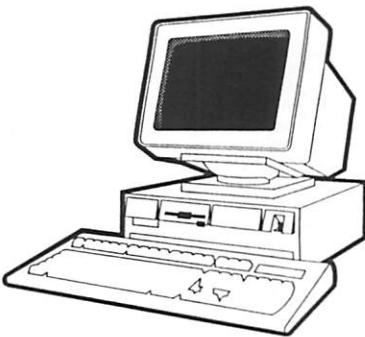

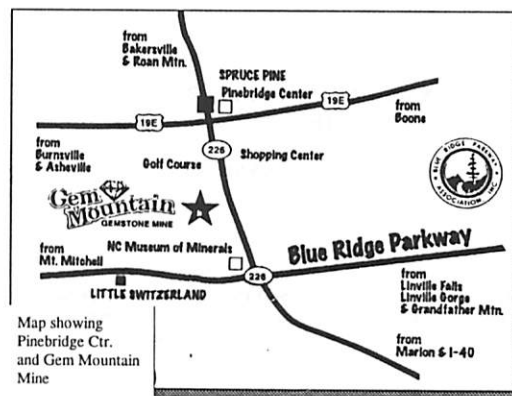
